

Full-Time Salvation Army Service Pathways

within the New Zealand, Fiji, Tonga & Samoa Territory

OFFICERSHIP (Cadet Pathway)

A Cadet has responded to a call from God to serve as a full-time Spiritual Leader in The Salvation Army.

This pathway usually begins with two years of residential training at Booth College of Mission, with the option of an individualised training programme depending on each person's background. After the successful completion of training, cadets are ordained as Ministers of Religion with authority to perform certain ceremonies (eg, weddings as registered marriage celebrants). Cadets are commissioned as Officers and receive their first appointment with the rank of lieutenant.

ENVOYSHIP

An Envoy has responded to a call from God to serve as a full-time Spiritual Leader in The Salvation Army.

The Envoyship Pathway does not involve residential training. Individuals are warranted for officer-equivalent work and engage in individualised training. Envoys are not ordained as Ministers of Religion, however they are able to be registered as marriage celebrants. Their term of service is renewable every three years, at which time the Envoy or The Salvation Army may choose to discontinue this warranted service. Envoys are not commissioned officers and therefore do not hold officer ranks (such as lieutenant or captain).

OFFICERSHIP (Auxiliary-Captaincy Pathway)

An Auxiliary-Captain has responded to a call from God to serve as a full-time Spiritual Leader in The Salvation Army.

The Auxiliary-Captaincy pathway is well suited to people with significant life and Christian ministry experience. Individuals are warranted as Auxiliary-Captains and appointed to fulfil duties usually undertaken by commissioned Officers. They do not undertake residential training, engaging instead in individualised training.

After seven years, Auxiliary-Captains can be ordained as Ministers of Religion and commissioned as Officers with the rank of captain.
